Extended Enrichment Hours

To support working parents or those with flexible schedules, we offer extended enrichment hours for students enrolled in our Homeschool Enrichment Academy at an additional cost. Extended enrichment hours are not available for our Project-Based Learning Classes

Extended Morning Enrichment

- 6:30 AM 8:00 AM
 - Activities: Students participate in calm, enriching activities such as reading or quiet independent projects before the regular program starts. This time can also include tutoring or arts & crafts.

Extended Afternoon Enrichment

- 3:30 PM 5:30 PM
 - Activities: Students engage in additional creative, project-based activities, or supervised outdoor play. This time can also include tutoring, games, or arts & crafts.

Project-Based Learning Classes

Our Project-Based Learning Classes focus on interdisciplinary, hands-on projects designed to integrate science, math, reading, social studies, and the arts. Students will work on a variety of short- and medium-term projects throughout the semester, developing critical thinking and creativity. Projects and Project Schedules are posted on our website.

Sample Projects:

- **Sustainable Gardening**: Students explore biology, math, and environmental science by designing and planting a sustainable garden, while integrating writing and art through journaling and design.
- **STEM Challenges**: Hands-on challenges where students solve real-world problems using science, technology, and math. Projects may include building models or designing simple engineering solutions.
- **Creative Storytelling & Documentary**: Students research historical events or create stories and then produce either a performance or a documentary to share their findings. This project blends social studies, drama, and technology.

Homeschool Enrichment Academy

Our Homeschool Enrichment Academy offers both full-day and half-day enrollment options one to five days per week, allowing flexibility for families. The academy is rooted in personalized learning, ensuring that each student can work at their own pace, whether they are ahead or need extra support in key academic areas.

Curriculum Options:

Our curriculum includes project-based learning alongside a core curriculum in math, reading, language arts, social studies and science that emphasizes personalized, self-paced learning and instruction. This allows students to engage deeply with both academic subjects and hands-on, real-world projects while receiving tailored guidance to meet their individual learning needs. Students and parents have the option to select which projects align with their personalized learning plan and will participate throughout the semester.

In addition, we offer flexibility for families who prefer to use their own curriculum:

• **Students with Their Own Curriculum**: Families can bring their own preferred educational materials, and we will help guide the students through their personalized learning plans. Our facilitators will provide support, and we can integrate project-based

activities that align with the student's own curriculum to ensure a balanced and enriching experience.

Language, Life Skills, & Arts Integration:

Our curriculum also incorporates creative arts, performance arts, language and life skills allowing students to express themselves while enhancing holistic learning.

Fridays

Fridays will alternate between field trips and fun friday activities.

- **Field Trips**: Field trips to local educational or cultural destinations (e.g., science museums, botanical gardens, historical landmarks). These trips will enhance the project-based learning curriculum and allow students to explore subjects hands-on.
- **Fun Friday Activities**: Fun Friday events include activities like creative arts workshops, outdoor sports, themed days, project showcases and more where students can share what they've learned in an enjoyable setting.

Lunch & Snacks

- **Full-Day Students**: Please pack a nutritious lunch and two snacks. Lunch break is an important social time for students to engage with peers and build relationships.
- Half-Day Students: Please bring one snack for the break.
- Allergy-Friendly: Please ensure food is allergy-friendly and avoid peanuts or tree nuts.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

- **Drop-Off:** Please follow student schedules for drop off time. We ask that students arrive no later than their drop off window end time. *Students enrolled in Extended Morning Enrichment may arrive as early as 6:30 AM.
- **Pick-Up:** Please follow student schedules for pick up times. Students enrolled in *Extended Afternoon Enrichment can stay until 5:30 PM. Students not enrolled in Extended Afternoon Enrichment must be picked up by their drop off window end time.
- Please ensure timely drop-offs and pick-ups to maintain a smooth and structured schedule.

*Extended Enrichment hours are not available for Project-Based Learning Classes

Tuition & Fees

- **Registration Fee:** \$50 per Semester
- Administrative Fee: \$100 per Semester

Project-Based Learning Classes

- **Tuition**: Includes two to four in-person 1.5 hour sessions per week, plus materials for projects.
 - **Monthly Tuition:** \$120
 - Semester Tuition: \$500

Homeschool Enrichment Academy

- **Curriculum Fee:** \$400 per Semester includes diagnostic assessments, personalized learning plan, and lesson activities (print and digital). This fee is waived for students who opt to use their own curriculum.
- Annual Evaluation Fee: \$75 (due when scheduled)
- **Full-Day Full-Time Program Tuition**: includes academic support, PBL, field trips, fun fridays, electives, and holiday camps
 - Semester Tuition: \$5,000 (Enrollment for full academic semester August -December <u>or</u> January - May)
 - **Annual Tuition:** \$8,800 (Enrollment for full academic year August May)
- Full-Day Part-Time Program Tuition: includes academic support and PBL
 - Monthly Tuition 1 Full Day per Week: \$352
 - Monthly Tuition 2 Full Days per Week: \$624
 - Monthly Tuition 3 Full Days per Week: \$816
- Half-Day 5-day Program Tuition: includes academic support, PBL, field trips, fun fridays, electives, and holiday camps
 - Semester Tuition: \$3,500 (Enrollment for full academic semester August -December <u>or</u> January - May)
 - **Annual Tuition:** \$6,160 (Enrollment for full academic year August May)

- Half-Day Part-Time Program Tuition: includes academic support and PBL
 - Monthly Tuition 1 Half Day per Week: \$211.20
 - Monthly Tuition 2 Half Days per Week: \$374.40
 - Monthly Tuition 3 Half Days per Week: \$489.60
- Fun Friday Add-On Fee: (Student must attend at least one day per week to add on)
 - Daily Fee: \$35
 - Monthly Fee: \$60
- Field Trip Add-On Fee: includes field trip admission and transportation (Student must attend at least one day per week to add on)
 - Daily Fee: \$75
 - Monthly Fee: \$135
- Friday Add-On Monthly Fee: \$180 includes field trips and Fun Fridays
- Extended Morning Enrichment
 - Weekly Fee: \$65
 - Drop-In Fee: \$15/occurrence
- Extended Afternoon Enrichment
 - Weekly Fee: \$80
 - Drop-In Fee: \$25/occurrence
- Combined Morning & Afternoon Enrichment
 - Weekly Fee: \$125
 - Drop-In Fee: \$35/occurrence

All tuition and fees are per student. We offer a 20% Sibling discount.
